Class 1 Walk / Trot Test - short arena

Combination of horse/pony and rider never to have been placed in any Prelim or above dressage competition or have won a walk/trot test (this class is aimed toward very novice horses / riders / combinations as an encouragement class. Test can be ridden on the lead rein). (Tests available from the secretary or upon request from info@swdrc.co.uk)

This is not a qualifier for the Championships on 20 September 2009

Class 2 Prelim 18 (2002) short arena

Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have won a dressage test within the last 3 years and/or horse/pony not to have more than 25 dressage points*.

This class is not a qualifier for the Championships on 20 September 2009

Class 3 Prelim 19 (2008) long arena

Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have won more than two dressage tests within the last 3 years and/or horse/pony not to have more than 25 dressage points*.

This class is a qualifier for the Championships on 20 September 2009

Class 4 Novice 28 (2008) short arena

Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have won more than twice at Novice level or above in the last 3 years and/or horse/pony not to have more than 124 dressage points*.

This class is not a qualifier for the Championships on 20 September 2009

Class 5 Novice 35 (2009) long arena

Horse/pony not to have more than 124 dressage points*.

This class is a qualifier for the Championships on 20 September 2009

Class 6 Elementary 43 (2006), Medium 61 (2002) long arena, Adv Medium 85

No restrictions. All tests will be judged within the same class. Placings are on overall percentage regardless of test ridden. Competitors can ride two different tests on the same horse. Please advise on entry form which test you wish to ride.

ENTRIES: Close Tuesday 12 May. Late entries £2 extra if space available. Cheques made payable to SWDRC.

ENTRY FEES: SWDRC member £6, non SWDRC member £9.

PRIZES: Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. Members rosette to highest placed SWDRC member in each class. Best Junior Member rosette to highest placed Junior SWDRC member. First to sixth from classes 3, 5 & 6 qualify for the Dressage Championship on Sunday 20 September 2009.

DRESSAGE SERIES POINTS TROPHY: A members points system will operate throughout the year. A junior and senior trophy is awarded at the AGM to the horse/pony and rider combination with the most accumulative points over the series. Points are only awarded once membership has been paid and are awarded according to percentage totals.

VENUE DIRECTIONS: Sparrows Hill Livery is situated on the B1052. Close to the B1052/B1383 junction.

NOTE: Competition arena outdoor surfaces 20m x 40m and 20m x 60m. Some short arena tests may be ridden in the long arena with boards to shorten to a 20m x 40m. Warm up area on grass. There may be no catering, toilet or first aid facilities at this event. **Competitors must take all their muck and rubbish home with them.**

RULES: Please see full rules before making an entry as receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Saffron Walden and District Riding Club.

- At all Saffron Walden & District Riding Club (SWDRC) events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with BSEN 4472/6473 or BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 (which are recommended by the British Riding Clubs). **FAILURE TO COMPLY INCURS IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.**
- In case of bad weather conditions please either call the secretary or tel: 07919 312041 for an event update.
- *Dressage Rule: "Downgraded Horses" - For every full year that a horse with affiliated dressage points remains unregistered, 12 points may be deducted when calculating eligibility for competitions.
- British dressage rules apply to all dressage events unless otherwise stated in the rules.
