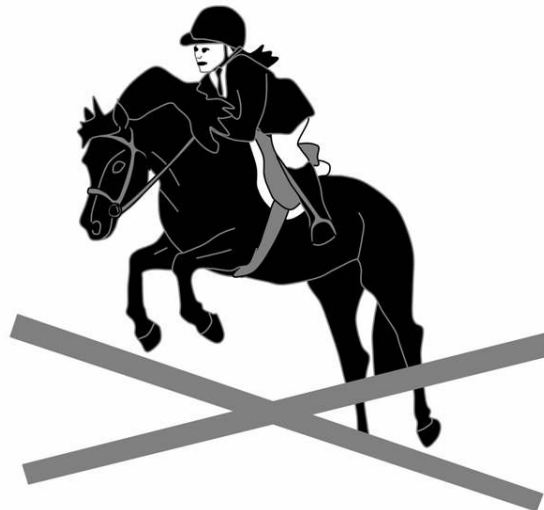

Start time: 10am sharp

- Class 1a** 1' lead rein
Combination may not enter class 3
- Class 1b** 1' off lead rein (may be given non-contact assistance)
Combination may not enter class 3
- Class 2a** 1'6" lead rein
- Class 2b** 1'6" off lead rein (may be given non-contact assistance)
- Class 3** 2' off lead rein (no assistance allowed)
Combination may not enter class 1

Please read the following carefully:

- No combination may enter more than two consecutive classes. Classes 1a and 1b will be run concurrently and classes 2a and 2b will be run concurrently.
- No rider to have competed in show jumping classes over 2' high.
- Class 3 will not commence before 11.30am, however please phone after 10.30am for specific times
- We are holding this series to encourage progression in show jumping. Competitors may be asked, at the judges' discretion, to move up a class if it is felt they are competing in a class below their ability.
- There will be a points system in operation, with a trophy awarded to the combination with the most points across all the classes. In addition, competitors may earn an extra two points at each event for helping to put up and/or clear away the jumps. Helpers need to be ready to set up at 9.30am.

Parking may be tight, please park thoughtfully.

Refreshments may be available.

ENTRIES: All classes £5.00 per class. Entries close the Wednesday before each competition. Entries on the day accepted if spaces available. Cheques made payable to: Saffron Walden & District Riding Club. By placing an entry you automatically agree to abide by the rules of the competition and the Club.

CHILDRENS VERY NOVICE INDOOR SHOW JUMPING POINTS SYSTEM: There will be a points system in operation, with a trophy awarded to the combination with the most points across all the classes. In addition, competitors may earn an extra two points at each event for helping to put up and/or clear away the jumps. Helpers need to be ready to set up at 9.30am.

VENUE DIRECTIONS: Brook Farm Equestrian Centre is situated on the B1054. On the way out of Radwinter heading towards Hempstead. COMPETITORS ARE KINDLY REQUESTED TO REMOVE ALL DROPPINGS AND TAKE THEIR RUBBISH HOME WITH THEM.

NOTE: Competition arena indoor 20m x 40m. Warm up area 20m x 40m outdoor surface. There may be no catering, toilet or first aid facilities at this event. **Competitors must take all their muck and rubbish home with them. PARKING CAN BE TIGHT, PLEASE PARK THOUGHTFULLY.**

RULES: Please see full rules before making an entry as receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Saffron Walden and District Riding Club.

- Informal riding wear may be worn at this event only, however ALL competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with BSEN 4472/6473 or BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 (which are recommended by the British Riding Clubs). **FAILURE TO COMPLY INCURS IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.**
- 15. In case of bad weather conditions please call the secretary for an event update.
- 19. BRC rules apply to all show jumping events unless otherwise stated in the rules.
 - The committee of the SWDRC, its judges and appointed officials accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to property belonging to competitors, grooms or spectators.
 - The committee reserves the right to refuse entry or to alter or cancel any class without giving a reason.
 - Any objection must be made in writing to the organizer within 30 minutes of the incident, together with a £10 deposit, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
 - Ponies must be over 4 years of age.
 - No dogs allowed.
 - All children must be fully supervised at all times.
 - Receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the SWDRC.
 - Reckless riding may incur elimination.
 - No whips over 75cm in length.
