- Class 1** **Clear Round** Fences approx 60cm (2'0")
10.00am Rosettes to all clear rounds
Entry fees: £4 on the day only - payable at ringside (please ensure you have correct money)
Last declarations to be taken at ringside by 10.30am. No further entries will be taken after this time.
- Class 2** **Minimus** Fences approx 60cm (2'0") first round
10.45am Combination of horse/pony and rider never to have been place 1st - 3rd in a show jumping class.
- Class 3** **Novice** Fences approx 69cm (2'3") first round
11.30am Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have been placed 1st – 3rd in a show jumping class at
Intermediate level or above.
- Class 4** **Intermediate** Fences approx 76cm (2'6") first round
12.15pm Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have won more than £50.
- Class 5** **Small Open** Fences approx 84cm (2'9") first round
1.00pm No restrictions.
- Class 6** **Open** Fences approx 91cm (3'0") first round
1.30pm No restrictions.

Times stated are just a guide – classes may start earlier or later depending on entries.

ENTRIES: Close on the Friday prior to the event. Members £4, Non SWDRC Members £6 per class. Late entries £2 extra. Entries on the day if numbers permit. Cheques made payable to: Saffron Walden & District Riding Club. By placing an entry you automatically agree to abide by the rules of the competition and the Club.

PRIZES: Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. Members rosette to highest placed SWDRC member in each class. First to sixth from all classes qualify for the Show Jumping Championship on Saturday 18 September 2010.

SHOW JUMPING POINTS SYSTEM: A points system will operate throughout the year with a points trophy being awarded at the AGM to the junior and senior SWDRC member and horse/pony combination with the most points at the end of the season. Points are only awarded once membership has been paid. Where classes are split horse/pony points will be awarded for both results.

VENUE DIRECTIONS: Sparrows Hill Livery is situated on the B1052. Close to the B1052/B1383 junction.

NOTE: Competitions will be run on grass. In the event wet weather please check www.swdrc.co.uk for an event update. There may be no catering, toilet or first aid facilities at this event. **Competitors must take all their muck and rubbish home with them.**

RULES: Please see full rules before making an entry as receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Saffron Walden and District Riding Club.

- At all Saffron Walden & District Riding Club (SWDRC) events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with BSEN 4472/6473 or BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 (which are recommended by the British Riding Clubs). **FAILURE TO COMPLY INCURS IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.**
- In case of bad weather conditions please either call the secretary or tel: 07919 312041 for an event update.
- Combinations of horse/pony and rider may compete in no more than two classes at any one competition (excluding clear round classes). Please note that the classes must be consecutive classes. Horses/ponies may only compete once in any one class. This rule also applies to the Championships – if a combination has qualified for more than two championship classes, the combination may only compete in two consecutive championship classes. – if a horse/pony has qualified for any championship class with more than one rider, then only one rider may compete in the championship class. See rule 2.
- BRC rules apply to all show jumping events unless otherwise stated in the rules.
