**FLU** - Please **DO** travel with your passport (as you legally should anyway). We are enforcing the 6 month booster. Do not travel if you have poorly horses on your yard. All ponies/horses must have had a valid flu vaccination within the past 6 months of the event in accordance with rule G7 of the British Riding Club Handbook. Spot checks will be made so you **MUST** bring your horse passport to the event with you.

At all Saffron Walden & District Riding Club events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 (which are recommended by the British Riding Clubs). Failure to comply incurs immediate elimination.

- TIMES:** Times stated are just a guide – classes may start earlier or later depending on entries. Real time updates on class start times may be found on the club Facebook page.
- ENTRY CLOSE:** 10pm Friday before the event\*. Entries taken on the day (space permitting) at £2 extra/class. If classes become full only pre-existing SWDRC member entries will be taken on the day. Any classes that are full prior to date of event will be advised on the club Facebook page.
- ENTRY FEES:** Mini Series: SWDRC Members: £4:00 Non-members: £6.00  
Main Series: SWDRC Members: £6:00 Non-members: £8.00  
Late entries and entries on the day £2.00 extra. All pre-event entries to be made online at [www.clubentries.co.uk/saffronrc](http://www.clubentries.co.uk/saffronrc)  
SWDRC Event Withdrawal Policy: Any participant withdrawing from an event before close of entries will be entitled to a full refund of any entry fees. After close of entries any participant withdrawing from an event will only be entitled to a refund of any entry fees paid upon receipt of a medical/veterinary certificate. Withdrawals on the day for medical/veterinary reasons may be entitled to a refund of entry fees paid at the discretion of the organiser.
- RESTRICTIONS:** No restrictions on any class, however should it become evident that a competitor is competing beneath their abilities, the committee may ask them to compete in a higher class.

Table A7: Jump a first round, then all clears go through to a second round timed “jump-off” where the fastest combination with the least faults wins.  
Two-phase: Jump round one and if clear go straight into the timed jump-off against the clock without interruption or halting in between rounds. If faults are incurred in the first round/section the judges will ring the bell to stop the rider going into the jump-off phase.
- PRIZES:** Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. Results may be split junior/senior if entries allow.  
**MAIN SERIES POINTS TROPHY:** A members points system will operate throughout the year with an award being presented at the AGM to the horse/pony and rider combination with the most accumulative points over the main series (see SWDRC rules). Points awarded only when membership is paid.
- FIRST AID:** First aid supplied by a suitably qualified FAW or BHS first aider volunteer.
- FALLS:** Due to H&S restrictions, any competitor falling off at this event (including car park, warm up or competition arena) will NOT be allowed to remount or partake further in any aspect of this event. Any entry fees paid for classes that have not yet taken place will be refunded.

# SAFFRON WALDEN & DISTRICT RIDING CLUB

## RULES AND CONDITION OF ENTRY



### Saffron Walden & District Riding Club Rules as at 24/03/2019.

1. Receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the event and Saffron Walden and District Riding Club (SWDRC). Non-members entering any event must hold their own appropriate Public Liability insurance (to a minimum value of £2 million) to compete at SWDRC events which must be available to check should it be requested.
2. It should be considered a condition of entry that each competitor and spectator shall indemnify the organisers or any person acting on their behalf against legal action arising from accident or incident.
3. Specific event rules will be included on schedules, receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by Club rules AND specific event rules.
4. At all SWDRC events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with PAS 015 1998 or 2011, VGA 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked. It is the competitors responsibility to comply to this rule. **FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY INCUR IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.**
5. It is the onus of the competitor to only compete in classes for which they are eligible. The organisers and helpers of any event are not responsible for policing the eligibility of competitors for each event. All class restrictions at SWDRC events are self-governing (ie. by entering a class at a SWDRC event the competitor agrees to the specific class restrictions). If it is found at any time during the event that the competitor is not eligible the competitor may be allowed to continue, however they will not be placed. If it is found after the event that this rule has not been adhered to any relevant points will not be awarded toward any members trophies and entries may be declined for future events.
6. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone should take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
7. Any instance of behaviour from any person on an event site that is deemed by the organisers or helpers of an event as rude, threatening or unacceptable will be asked to leave the site immediately with no refund of outstanding entry fee and may be prohibited from attending any further SWDRC events.
8. No persons other than the organisers and helpers may approach a SWDRC appointed Judge or Scorer during a competition, unless requested to do so by the Judge or official steward.
9. Any objection must be made in writing to the organiser within 15 minutes of an incident, together with a £10 deposit, which will be refunded only if the objection is upheld.
10. The committee of the Saffron Walden & District Riding Club, its Judges and appointed officials accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to property belonging to competitors, grooms or spectators.
11. Only members whose details have been received through an official Riding Club at BRC headquarters are covered by BRC insurance at events. BRC insurance covers the named person only, owners of horses/ponies who are not BRC members are not covered by BRC insurance and must hold their own insurance.
12. Riders must be suitably mounted, SWDRC committee/organisers decision is final.
13. BRC rules apply to events unless otherwise stated in the rules.
14. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry, alter or cancel any class without giving a reason.
15. The Judges decision is final.
16. Horses and ponies competing must be 4 years and over unless specifically stated.
17. Reckless, dangerous or inexperienced riding may incur elimination.
18. No rider may carry a whip exceeding 75cm in length, except for dressage events.
19. Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times and under control.
20. In case of bad weather conditions please check club Facebook or web page for event updates.
21. For all series trophies and events: Should it become evident that a competitor is competing beneath their abilities, the committee may ask them to compete in a higher standard class.
22. If you do not wish any attending photographer to take your photo or publish images on their web site, you must advise the photographer directly.
