SWDRC Camp 2020

Keysoe, 17th – 19th May

IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN ATTENDING CAMP, YOU NEED TO BE A MEMBER AND LET US KNOW BY 25 JANUARY WHAT DISCIPLINES YOU WOULD LIKE TO DO – see end of this document for further detail.

Only SENIOR SWDRC members can attend this camp.

PLEASE NOTE: The organisers of the camp are also camp attendees, paying the same rate as every other camper, they have kindly agreed to organise camp on behalf of everyone, but we expect all campers to help out as and when required and try to work through any problems themselves so the organisers can have as much fun at camp as everyone else.

Arrival day is evening of Sunday 17th May, riding days are 18th & 19th May
18th - 2 riding sessions (am and pm)
19th - 1 or 2 riding sessions (you choose)

You can choose how to make up your 3 or 4 sessions from:

- Dressage (*max of 2 individual sessions per horse*)
- Polework (*group*)
- Show Jumping (*group*) (please indicate max height you want to jump and how confident you are as a rider)
- XC (*group*) (*max of 2 sessions allowed per horse*) *please note that if there is a problem using the XC course, then SJ session will replace.*
**If you wish to have more than one session of XC then there will be a surcharge of £20.*

(You can make up your sessions however you like, a selection of one of each, 2 of one and 2 of another, you do not have to do every discipline)

Groups will be organised around chosen disciplines, level and instructor availability (dressage will be one to one instruction unless otherwise stated, all other disciplines will be group lessons of approx 4 people). If you are attending with friends and just want to be in the same groups despite ability (with respect to jumping), then let us know now and we can try to accommodate.

Cost will be *approx £230* (hopefully this cost will be less but Keysoe have increased their prices) we will know final price when we have received all deposits; includes tuition, stabling (not bedding), 3 main meals/day and hire of the facilities* (extra meals for non riders / accompanying adults can be accommodated at £20/day (£40 for the duration of camp)). All

meals are included from Sunday night until Tuesday lunchtime. A non-refundable deposit of £120 will be due by early February and the balance due early April.

You will need to provide your own horse hay, feed and bedding (you can purchase bedding direct from Keysoe). You will need to provide your own accommodation, in your lorry/trailer/tent, etc. Showers are available. Hook up is available at additional cost, booked direct with Keysoe.
