Competitors jump a short course of show jumps followed immediately by a short course of cross-country fences (including water). Each phase will be timed separately, penalties will be accrued through jumping penalties, exceeding optimum time for show jumping phase and any seconds away from optimum time for cross-country phase. Cross-country fences are solid fences (not knock-down).

Class 1 70cm Arena Eventing

Class 2 80cm Arena Eventing

Class 3 90cm Arena Eventing

Class 4 100cm Arena Eventing

Show jumping speed 340mpm, cross-country speed 375mpm

RESTRICTIONS: There are no horse or rider restrictions on any of the classes
ENTRIES OPEN: 23rd February 2022 and will be STRICTLY limited
ENTRY CLOSE: 16th March 2022 (or when classes are full)
ENTRY FEE: £19.00. NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

TIMES: Each competitor will be allocated a time for each round. Times will be emailed out to competitors by Thursday 17th March (please check your SPAM folder if you do not receive these).
PRIZES: Rosettes to 6th place in all classes.
WARM UP: Numbers in warm up area(s) may be limited and warm up times may be allocated

By entering this competition, you agree to us using the information provided to process your entry. RULES: All rules in accordance with the BRC Official Rule Book 2022
DIRECTIONS: Horseheath is located on the A1307 between Linton and Haverhill

Body protectors must be worn and must have either a Level 3 2009 or after PURPLE label OR a BLUE 2018 label.

Skull caps must be worn with a silk. Fixed peaks are not permitted.

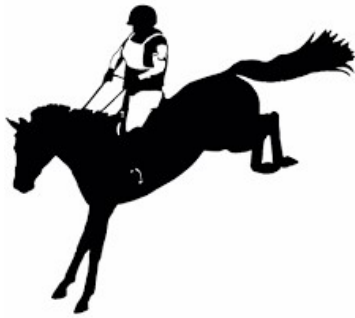
British: PAS 015: 1998* or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC Marked VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC Marked

European: VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC Marked

American: ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001* and SNELL E2016

Australian and New Zealand: AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked

Cross country bib and number must be supplied by each competitor, numbers will be advised with times and must be CLEARLY shown, the number should be visible from a distance.



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Essex Riding Club Rules:

1. Receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the event and Essex Riding Clubs (ERC). Entrants must hold their own appropriate Public Liability insurance (to a minimum value of £2 million) to compete at ERC events which must be available to check should it be requested.
2. It should be considered a condition of entry that each competitor and spectator shall indemnify the organisers or any person acting on their behalf against legal action arising from accident or incident.
3. Horse/pony and rider combinations should have previously completed successfully a jumping round of a similar height.
4. Receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by Club rules AND specific event rules.
5. At all ERC events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with PAS 015 1998 or 2011, VGA 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked. It is the competitor's responsibility to comply to this rule. FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY INCUR IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.
6. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone should take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
7. Any instance of behavior from any person on an event site that is deemed by the organisers or helpers of an event as rude, threatening or unacceptable will be asked to leave the site immediately with no refund of outstanding entry fee and may be prohibited from attending any further ERC events.
8. No persons other than the organisers and helpers may approach a ERC appointed Judge or Scorer during a competition, unless requested to do so by the Judge or official steward.
9. Any objection must be made in writing to the organiser within 15 minutes of an incident, together with a £10 deposit, which will be refunded only if the objection is upheld.
10. The committee of the Essex Riding Club, its Judges and appointed officials accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to property belonging to competitors, grooms or spectators.
11. Only members whose details have been received through an official Riding Club at BRC headquarters are covered by BRC insurance at events. BRC insurance covers the named person only, owners of horses/ponies who are not BRC members are not covered by BRC insurance and must hold their own insurance.
12. Riders must be suitably mounted, ERC committee/organisers decision is final.
13. BRC rules apply to events unless otherwise stated in the rules.
14. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry, alter or cancel any class without giving a reason.
15. The Judge's decision is final.
16. Horses and ponies competing must be 4 years and over unless specifically stated.
17. Reckless, dangerous or inexperienced riding may incur elimination.
18. No rider may carry a whip exceeding 75cm in length, except for dressage events.
19. Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times and under control.
20. In case of bad weather conditions please check BRC Area 8 - Essex Liaison Facebook for event updates, please also check your email (including SPAM) for updates.
21. If you do not wish any attending photographer to take your photo or publish images on their web site, you must advise the photographer directly.
