Results

Results will be published on SWDRC social media on the 20 February, test sheets will be emailed to each competitor. Rosettes to 6th place in each class will be posted out.



You do not have to wear competition wear. If competition attire is worn, then the horse or pony must wear boots or bandages to clearly demonstrate that the test has not been recorded at a competition.

- Riding hats must be worn. Suitable footwear with a heel must be worn for safety reasons.
- ✓ Bridles For Intro, Prelim and Novice tests ordinary snaffle bridle; Elementary and above – ordinary snaffle or double bridle.
- ✓ Bits BD permitted bits only.
- \checkmark Neck straps or balancing straps may be used at all levels.
- ✓ Boots or bandages may be worn.
- ✓ Nose nets and fly veils are permitted (with exception of tie down veils).
- * Bit guards, martingales, side, running or elasticized reins may not be used in any class.
- * Belly bands are not permitted.
- * No exercise fleeces or sheets to be worn.

HOW TO FILM YOUR TEST

- 1. For a short example of how to film a dressage test, please see <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=837zqGJ9lFg</u>
- 2. The person videoing MUST be **positioned a couple of metres behind C**, holding the phone **landscape** (if the video is in portrait you will lose 2 marks). **Zoom** in/out so the horse and rider are kept in the centre of the screen and as much as is possible take up approximately half the screen image at all times. If you disappear from view, the judge will not be able to score you for those movements, however the judge needs to see where you are in the arena.
- 3. You need to be in a marked arena with correct measurements (20mx40m) either on grass or in a school. Markers MUST be clearly displayed.
- 4. The **video must have sound** (if it does not your test will still be marked but you will not be eligible for a placing) you **may have a caller** for the test but you **may not have training help**.
- 5. Your video must have **no cuts or edits**. It must start at least 2 seconds before the rider enters at A and preferably 4 seconds after the rider salutes at the end.
- 6. Either you or the person videoing your test **MUST verbally introduce the video** you must include *your name* and the *horses name*, the *test to be performed* and the *date of filming*. If you are not introduced or don't include the date you may be deducted 2 marks.
- 7. Saluting. BD rules state you hold the reins (and whip if carried) in one hand and the other hand is lowered to the rider's side. The rider should nod their head. As per BD rules if you salute with the whip hand you will be deducted 2 marks.
- 8. When **naming your file**, please include rider name and horse name as the file name.

HOW TO UPLOAD YOUR VIDEO

Upload your video to YouTube and then include the link in the "Special Requests" section of the online entry form. If you wish to keep your YouTube video private, please set the settings to Unlisted. DO NOT set it as private otherwise the judge will not be able to see it.
